CAT 2018





































Following quick information may be useful for candidates appearing for CAT 2018 examination:

- CAT 2018 is scheduled to be conducted in 374 test centres spread across 147 cities in
- Approximately 2.41 lakh candidates have applied successfully for CAT 2018.
- CAT will be conducted in two shifts on 25th November, 2018: a) Morning 9:00 AM 12:00 noon and Afternoon 2:30 PM – 5:30 PM
- Candidates are advised to report at 7:30 AM for the morning shift and at 1:00 PM for the afternoon shift.
- CAT is a 3-hour examination comprising of three sections: i) Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension, ii) Quantitative Ability, and iii) Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning. Candidates will be given one hour for each section, PwD candidates will get 20 minutes extra for each section.
- Candidates are required to download their admit cards from CAT website, take a printout, affix their photo (same as uploaded in application form) and bring to the test centre along with identity proofs.
- Candidates are advised to carefully read all the instructions provided on the Admit Card and adhere to them. PwD candidates with scribe should complete all formalities as explained on CAT website.
- Candidates are advised to locate the test venue in advance and to start well in advance to reach their CAT 2018 test centre in time.
- Candidates are advised to go through the test day help guide uploaded on CAT website to get themselves familiarised with security and other exam day procedures.
